AICM in Kabale has connections with many rural communities, including the Batwa Pygmy villages, where many poor or orphaned children can be helped to attend through your gifts

Your gift could make a difference ... GETTING ABOUT

AICM needs transport to access the rural communities in which it carries out most of its work. The extension workers usually travel by bicycle, but also have the use of a motorbike. AICM also owns two vehicles. Maintenance of all these is costly and lack of funds for this often puts bikes or vehicles out of action. These very practical gifts can help keep them on the road.

£5 will provide a voucher for bicycle maintenance and repair.

Vehicle vouchers

£10, £20 or £30 will provide a voucher for fuel and repair of vehicles. The two vehicles each need £20 of fuel each week, the motorbike needs £10 of fuel each week.

Your gift could make a difference ... IN THE RURAL COMMUNITIES



Land is one thing that is easily available in rural Uganda, although it is often high up and not easily accessible. The land is fertile if well cultivated. The many poor families AICM are helping need suitable equipment and also main crop seeds to plant.

It is also easy to graze animals, such as sheep and goats, and these are an excellent gift for these needy communities.

AICM provides extension workers who travel out into the country side and carry out vital work of encouragement and training. Without them many of these families would be unsupported and neglected.

Pangas and hoes

£10 will provide pangas and hoes — essential tools to help till the land.

Sack of seed potatoes

£20 will provide a sack of seed potatoes or other main crop seeds.

Salary for a field worker

£20 will give one month's salary for an extension or field worker.

Crop sprayer pump

£60 will provide a crop sprayer pump. This is an essential piece of equipment for pest and disease control in Uganda. It is something no one in the communities can afford, but having one makes a vast difference to the crop yield.

Sheep or goats

£32 will buy 2 sheep or goats.



Small herds of sheep and goats can yield many benefits — milk to drink, droppings for fertilizer to help grow better vegetables, and kids or lambs which means your gift goes on and on.
